FVTA Amnesty Certification Registration Form

Purpose: The purpose of certification Amnesty is recertification of Florida Veterinary Technicians that have lapsed in their bi-annual certification for more than two (2) cycles.

Currently, if a Florida Veterinary Technician has lapsed for more than two (2) cycles, the Veterinary Technician National Exam must be taken at a cost to the veterinary technician of \$300.00.

The Florida Veterinary Technician Association has taken measures to permit technicians to be reinstated at a fee of \$200.00 for processing the application. This will be a one-time fee and will cover the cost of recertification and membership to the FVTA until the next certification cycle.

Criteria for Reinstatement of Certification Florida Veterinary Technician Association:

1. Applicant must have graduated from an accredited college in Veterinary Technology.
2. Applicant must have held a certification in Florida or show proof of certification, licensure, or registration from another state and must have last certification number.
3. Applicant must be able to prove 15 hours of continuing education for every 2-year cycle with a maximum of 45 hours.
4. Applicant must pay to the Florida Veterinary Technician Association the fee of \$200.00 for processing the certification.

The \$200.00 will permit the technician to receive full membership to the FVTA and a new certification card with number.
