## **About The Role**

The work you'll be helping us to do at Southeast Veterinary Neurology matters because we do amazing things like help paralyzed animals walk again so they can enjoy life with their owners. This role in particular will involve you working as a technician with the after hours team once trained as a swing shift.

Duties will include:

- Being a team player and bridging the gap between day and night shift transitions.
- Providing animal care and medication administration to hospitalized patients.
- Monitoring all hospitalized patients throughout the night and relaying information to doctors about patient status.
- History taking from pet parents and helping our neurologist with exams that come in after hours.
- Assist with admission of new after-hours patients by placing IV catheters, collecting blood/urine as needed for testing and documents required for admission.
- Patient monitoring during anesthesia
- Communicating with pet parents and providing updates on their pet's status as needed

Evenings, weekends and holiday assignments are required for this role. But you will be compensated accordingly for the antisocial hours.
